Mt Gravatt District School Sport 2021

Mt Gravatt District Sport Trials allow any student from across the district to be nominated by their school to trial for a Mt Gravatt representative sporting team. If a student is successful in being selected for the Mt Gravatt Team in a particular sport they are then given the opportunity to compete at the Regional Carnival (pathway Qld and National School Championships).

If you are interested in any of the trials on offer please do not hesitate to ask Mr McAndrew - 4 WEEKS before any trial so information and paper work can be passed on. Remember to be eligible for a trial, students must be of the right age and have prior experience playing that specific sport (play the specific sport at a club level). In some cases a student maybe invited to trial for a particular sport if they possess skills in certain areas. e.g. a student could be asked to trial for cricket if they have played softball before.

Details and the 2021 trial calendar are on display outside the staffroom on the noticeboard. (Students need to be 10 to 12 years old to participate and have high ability)
